

# Git userContent plugin

## Plugin Information

Jenkins has a mechanism known as "User Content", where administrators can place files inside `$_JENKINS_HOME/userContent`, and these files are served from <http://yourhost/jenkins/userContent>. This can be thought of as a mini HTTP server to serve images, stylesheets, and other static resources that you can use from various description fields inside Jenkins.

This plugin exposes this `$_JENKINS_HOME/userContent` directory as a Git repository, allowing administrators to use git to push/pull changes and manage them with history.

Once this plugin is installed, see <http://yourserver/jenkins/userContent.git> in your browser for how to access this repository.
