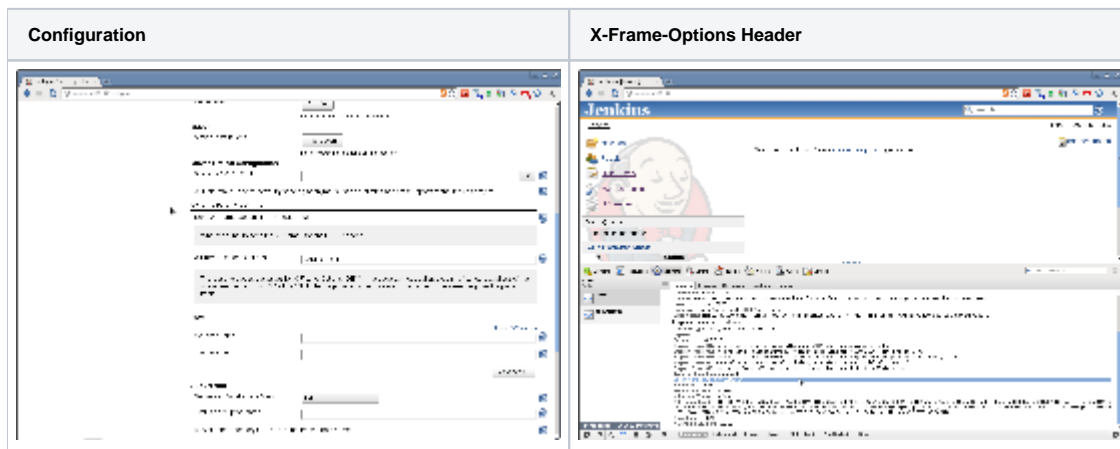
## XFrame Filter Plugin

### Plugin Information

View XFrame Filter [on the plugin site](#) for more information.

Provides a very simple filter which adds a response header indicating how frame/iframe requests should be handled.

The [X-Frame-Options HTTP response header](#) can be used to indicate whether or not a browser should be allowed to render a page in a frame or iframe. Sites can use this to avoid clickjacking attacks, by ensuring that their content is not embedded into other sites.
