


Gant Plugin

Plugin Information

No information for the plugin 'gant' is available. It may have been removed from distribution.

This plugin allows Hudson to invoke [Gant](#) build script as the main build step.

The plugin works much like Ant builder, and using it is very easy. You basically just need to specify the Gant targets that you want to run:

Invoke Gant script 

Ant Version

Targets

Specify Gant target(s) to run. If necessary, you can also specify any gant command line options. Also, [some environment variables are available to the build script](#)

If 'gant' is not in PATH, or if you have multiple Gant installations and need to be able to configure which project uses which Gant, then you can go to the system configuration and tell Hudson where your Gants are:

Gant

Gant installation	name	<input type="text" value="groovy 1.0 + gant 0.3"/>
	GROOVY_HOME	<input type="text" value="c:\development\versioned\groovy-1.0-gant-0.3"/>
		<input type="button" value="Delete"/>

As of 0.3, [Gant doesn't report the build status by its exit code](#), so to keep track of a build failure, you'll need to use [Text-finder Plugin](#) to recognize a build failure.
